

Spanish Beauty (2YO)



**2YO Filly for by Paco Boy
Trained by Ollie Pears, Malton**

This filly is a good looking daughter of the multiple Group winning sire Paco Boy. This filly has the same striking white blaze down her head which her father has - hopefully she will be just as good as him! She should be ready to race a month or two into the 2016 turf season as she is bred to be a six or seven furlong horse. She is very well bred, with a full brother who is currently rated 76 after only four races. She is currently in full training at our 2YO base in Malton with trainer Ollie Pears who managed to provide us with two winning 2YO's for our shareholders in 2015. She was bought at Tattersalls in October 2015 and will start in Maidens before broadening her target races. This filly covers the ground exceptionally well, and comes from a robust family - she will be an interesting type to follow through winter and into her 2016 flat season. She will race in the North and Midlands for her shareholders through the summer.

I Call the Shots (2YO)



**2YO Colt by Delegator
Trained by Ollie Pears in East Yorkshire**

Trained by Ollie Pears, based in Malton, this colt is one of the first offspring by the new sire Delegator - a Group performer for Godolphin. He is an early foal, and is already well developed, with a powerful physique and has all the makings of being an early, sprint type, being out of a multiple winning sprinter. His dam won twice as a 2YO, both times over five furlongs. There is plenty to like about him, being a good size, and he already has the look of an early sprinter about him. He is well confirmed, walks with a good stride and has a fluid trot. Ollie believes the colt shows all the signs of being a strong, early 2YO type - the reason we bought him. The colt is already at Ollie's yard in Malton and will be broken and overwintered with his trainer to ensure he is ready to race once the season starts in 2016. He is the second offspring and comes from a winning family. This colt would be a share suitable for any Northern-based racing enthusiast, his share period runs until November 2016 and we expect him to race right through the summer period.

Roaring Rory (3YO)



**3YO Gelding by Sakhee's Secret
Trained by Ollie Pears in East Yorkshire**

Trained by Ollie Pears in Malton, we have had a huge amount of fun with 'Rory' in 2015. He is a well proportioned sprinter, is powerful and a very robust gelding who takes his racing really well. He has already raced seven times as a 2YO, WINNING once and being placed a further three times. He is a well confirmed, extremely enthusiastic racehorse who loves to compete and always puts in 100%. Ollie is looking forward to this gelding's 3YO handicapping campaign in 2016, as he will start him off on the All-Weather in February or March before going onto the turf through the summer. Roaring Rory has already won for shareholders and given his racing style, we expect him to run very regularly and expect to pick up further wins with him. He's a good-looking, lovely natured young horse suitable for any racing enthusiast, great value for money, and his share period runs until the end of the flat season in November 2016. He will run on the All-Weather and the Turf during his share period.

Dyna Might (2YO)



**2YO Filly by Foxwedge
Trained by Ollie Pears in East Yorkshire**

As with all our young horses in the North, this youngster is trained by proven 2YO trainer, Ollie Pears, based in Malton. This filly has a powerful physique and all the makings of being an early, sprint type, being out of a Group 1 sprinter and with 100% winners within her close family. She is already a very good size, and we chose this filly because she has a very striking head, good confirmation and plenty of spirit.

She is a very forward, energetic sort, and being an early foal has plenty of height. The filly will be racing throughout the North and Midlands through 2016, starting in Maidens and progressing through her season from there. By first-season sire Foxwedge, she should be capable of racing over five and six furlongs in the early part of the season. Ollie has done well with first season sires in the past and this, as yet unnamed filly, has the stamp of a very forward sort.

Primo Rossi (6YO)



**6YO Gelding by Primo Valentino
Trained by Tom Gretton in Warwickshire**

Primo Rossi is a summer jumper and improved all the way through his 2015 campaign. He is a smashing syndicate horse who loves the firmer ground through spring and summer and so his trainer Tommy Gretton will be producing him to compete from March 2016 onwards. This will be a special season for the 7YO, as he will progress from hurdling to chasing. This gelding has been brought along quietly and patiently by trainer Tom Gretton and that patience has started to bear fruit. Primo Rossi showed ability in bumpers, took a little while to find his feet in hurdles, but his last three races in 2015 showed plenty of promise with two placings. He has shown enough to suggest he will be able to win over hurdles, and having already schooled over chase fences, he jumps well and will have plenty of racing options. We strongly believe there is a lot more to come from this good-looking, likeable young jumper. Tommy believes he will continue to improve after his winter break.

Little Jimmy (8YO)



**8YO Gelding by Passing Glance
Trained by Tom Gretton in Warwickshire**

Little Jimmy is a standing dish at the Tom Gretton yard and we are delighted to have become involved with this gelding. He is a robust and successful chaser, with six wins already for his shareholders and a 50% win/place strike rate. Little Jimmy has already won over £30,000 in prizemoney. Last season he won twice and was placed a further four times - earning over £9,000 in prizemoney. This eight-year-old is reaching the peak of his ability now, and we are excited to be offering shares in him for his 2016-17 season. He will start his campaign in Autumn, racing in the Midlands and South, racing right through to the end of the National Hunt season in April 2016. Competitive over chase fences in handicaps and over a variety of distances, he rarely puts in a poor performance. His trainer Tom Gretton knows this horse inside out, and shareholders should have a competitive season of racing from him.

Callaghan (3YO)



**3YO Gelding by Cacique
Trained by Tom Gretton in Worcestershire**

Callaghan is a lightly raced 2YO who has been bought with the express purpose of taking him Juvenile Hurdling through the summer of 2016. Rated a very decent 69 on the flat, he has only raced a few times, finishing second over seven furlongs before looking like he went over the top at the end of summer - but he is bred to be racing over a mile and half or even further. Trainer Tommy Gretton will be racing him on the flat in spring, in order to get the gelding going, and then he will switch to race in the very early juvenile hurdle races. We had a huge amount of success and fun with a similar horse trained by Tommy in 2015, and we are expecting to enjoy similar days at the races with this very well bred individual.

Juvenile Hurdle races attract good prizemoney and we aim to have Callaghan schooled up, ready for the start of the summer jumps season. If things go his way, we hope to have a crack at some of the better 3YO hurdle races with him at the end of the summer season.

Only **one share** (0.2%) is required to qualify for prizemoney in this aspiring National Hunt horse.

Nicely Indeed (6YO)



**6YO Gelding by
Trained by Seamus Durack in Berkshire**

Nicely Indeed is an Irish import, a gelding sourced by his trainer Seamus Durack - and he **WON** his first TWO opening races in National Hunt Flat races before getting injured in finishing 5th at Cheltenham. He is trained at Seamus's Lambourn yard and will be continuing his career over hurdles through the winter. His debut was nothing short of impressive, beating an odds-on favourite with ease by three lengths. Costing £16,000, he is a proper jumping type, from the family of Fifty Dollars More and Coolbeg Dude and stands over 16 hands high. He is an impressive unit and we expect to see him Novice hurdling in quality races through the winter.

Orithia (2YO)



**2YO Filly by More Than Ready
Trained by Seamus Durack in Berkshire**

A 2YO filly with this sort of breeding and cost is rarely available to small share syndicates, but we are delighted to be offering shares for her 2YO season in 2016. She was a 40,000 guineas purchase in the Book 2 Tattersalls Yearling Sale. Beautifully bred for sprinting, she already possesses all the signs of being an early 2YO. A superbly well made filly with near 100% correct confirmation, we were knocked out by her poise and presence at the sales and we were very keen to acquire her. This sprint-bred sort should be a proper precocious youngster, being by a much sought after US based sire with plenty of Group 1 winning offspring. As yet un-named, she is in training at Lambourn, Berkshire with proven trainer Seamus Durack and has a top drawer pedigree. She has size and scope, offering her shareholders the opportunity to follow the exploits of a young horse who has the makings of a precocious, winning two-year-old.

Fire Engine (2YO)



**2YO Colt by Compton Place
Trained by Ollie Pears in East Yorkshire**

Trainer Ollie Pears already has this colt pegged as an early sprinting 2YO. He has excellent sprint breeding, coming from a mare who was a multiple sprint winner, a top class sprint sire in Compton Place, and he has **two winning siblings from two runners**, both of a decent grade and both in sprints!

He also looks a picture, with a commanding head, and the compact, powerful stature which you look for in young, potentially early sprinters. We were very surprised to be able to afford this colt, as with his pedigree we expected him to be priced out of our range - and for any shareholder wanting to get early runs from their horse, he is an obvious choice. Ollie has reported that he is quite forward, and has a good nature, and he will be ridden away before November. It will be interesting to see how he develops physically over the winter, as this colt currently looks like he could be racing very early in 2016.

High Wells (3YO)



**2YO Colt by High Chapparral
Trained by Seamus Durack in Berkshire**

Seamus Durack was very keen on this High Chapparral Colt when he saw him at the Tattersalls Yearling sale in Newmarket. He is a statuesque, impressive individual and very correct and powerful looking - worth every bit of his 28,000 guines pricetag. He is already at Seamus Durack's training yard in Lambourn, and is being prepared for a season of flat racing as a 2YO in 2016, expecting to race at tracks in the South and Midlands. This son of Derby winner High Chapparral is beautifully bred, but on top of his breeding he has plenty of size and scope. He is in training at Lambourn, Berkshire with emerging trainer Seamus Durack. This colt will probably get as far as a mile in his 2YO career, and offers shareholders the opportunity to follow the exploits of a young horse who has credentials which should ensure success on the track. An excellent choice for southern based shareholders seeking to be involved in potentially high quality racehorse from the start of its career.

Snow Rescue (4YO)



**4YO Gelding by Stowaway
Trained by Seamus Durack in Berkshire**

We are very excited by this young, un-raced National Hunt horse. Trainer Seamus Durack really rates this son of Stowaway, and he has been quietly impressive in his work up the Lambourn gallops since arriving at the yard six weeks ago. He is a four-year-old grey gelding who comes with a very big reputation, from a Irish stud responsible for his half-brother, Champagne Fever.

Snow Rescue stands at 16 hands, and is heading for a Bumper campaign through spring and summer. Judging on his work at home, plus Seamus's ability to train these young Novice Hurdlers, the expectation is that this good-looking gelding will be a very interesting prospect. This is a special share period, representing good value for money - and which will guarantee shareholders an ongoing share in the gelding in the future. He will be racing in National Hunt Flat races from May onwards and then will go Novice Hurdling in late summer or early Autumn. Please note that **only ONE share** is required in this gelding to qualify for prizemoney payments.

Norton Warrior (3YO)



**3YO Gelding by Elnadim
Trained by Ollie Pears in North Yorkshire**

This colt is beautifully bred - by one of the leading sires of the last decade, Elnadim, and out of a winning mare by another top sire, Cape Cross. This colt was well bought at the Doncaster sales in November and will be racing as a 3YO in 2015.

He is a striking chesnut, taking his colourings from his father, and has plenty of length and scope to him. Ollie Pears is expecting this colt to start his career over six and seven furlongs and then progress to even longer distances. He is classically bred, with his siblings making £40,000 and £18,000 at sale (his mother cost 240,000 guineas as a yearling). A promising 3YO type with the sort of pedigree which could see him go far on the turf. Ollie Pears trains him in Malton, North Yorkshire.

Applejack Lad (4YO)



**4YO Gelding by Three Valleys
Trained by Michael Smith in Northumberland**

Having joined Michael Smith's yard in Northumberland Applejack Lad (or 'Jack' to his shareholders) has been successful and incredibly consistent. He finished in the prizemoney in four of his five races on the flat last summer, including two second placings - and so far this winter has run two promising races over hurdles. This gelding is robust and always tries hard in his races - rarely running a poor race. His pedigree is laden with stamina on both sides, and he has been successful stepped up in trip for 1m2f and 1m 4f races on turf and he has already shown he has no problem with two miles over hurdles. He is currently actively racing in his winter share period, and this share period will see the gelding continue into the summer and right through to the end of the year. Based in Northumberland, he will race around the North and Scotland and to date has proved to be excellent value for money. He is adored by his shareholders and is a horse who is great fun to be involved with. Please note that only **one share** (0.3%) is required in 'Jack' to qualify for prizemoney payments.

Kilgefin Star (8YO)



**8YO Gelding by Sadlers Hall
Trained by Michael Smith in Northumberland**

We are delighted to be offering Kilgefin Star for syndication this coming **winter jumps season**. This 8YO is in his prime, and has already proved himself to be a serious National Hunt racehorse, having already **won twice and been placed on many occasions** both over hurdles and chase fences. This gelding is trained in Northumberland by Michael Smith, and will provide his shareholders with a winter of jumping action. He is rated 125+ over both types of fences, which guarantees involvement in Grade 3 and 4 rated races - with prizemoney ranging between £4k-£11k per race. His last two races in Spring 2105 saw him run well to be placed third in two chase races, but that is not unusual, as this gelding has been very consistent throughout his entire career to date, rarely being out of the first four horses home. He is a quality National Hunt racehorse who should provide Northern-based shareholders with some great days at the races. Please note that **two shares** (0.4%) are required in this horse if you wish to qualify for prizemoney payments.

Race Time (3YO)



**3YO Filly by
Trained by Seamus Durack in Berkshire**

This unraced filly has a very desirable pedigree. In fact, she was bought at a yearling for 100,000 dollars by Sheikh Mohammed's Godolphin because she has two sisters who both proved to be capable in Group company. Seamus Durack, based in Lambourn, trains this 3YO filly, who missed her 2YO season because she needed to grow and mature, but will be ready to race in the South and Midlands through the spring and summer. She will need around seven furlongs to a mile and is expected to start her race career in Maidens from May onwards. She comes with high recommendations, and we are delighted to be offering her for syndication. If she can prove to be as useful as her sisters this syndicate should have a lot of fun following her exploits through the 2016 season. Please note that only **ONE share** (0.25%) is required in this 3YO to qualify for prizemoney payments and she is available at a very affordable price for a filly of this pedigree and trained at such a prestigious location.
